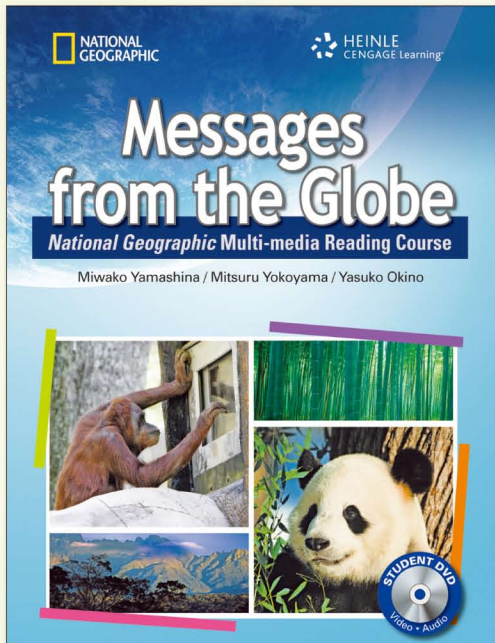

次の文章を読んで、おとの問題に答えよう。

When you see him happily swimming around, it is hard to think that Cupid is lucky to be alive. On February 14, 2003, this bottlenose dolphin was found stranded on a beach in Texas. Tammy Renaud of the Texas Marine Mammal Stranding Network describes what Cupid was like when he was first found. "When we first saw him on the beach, he was very lethargic," she explains. "He just looked pathetic. He was just a sad little dolphin lying on the beach needing help."

Nobody knows exactly how Cupid became stranded that Valentine's Day, but it is not unusual for dolphins or whales to be found on beaches. Thousands of marine animals are stranded every year, and many of them do not survive. Renaud explains why these strandings occur. "Strandings can happen due to illness, due to injury due to a number of things," she says.

A stranded whale or dolphin is in immediate danger and will usually die within days, sometimes even hours. If the animal is released directly back into the ocean, it will probably die, get stranded again, or be eaten by predators. However, if the animal stays on the beach without human help, it will certainly die as well.
